RE. ARTICULATION FROM THE HPCSA MT

REGISTER TO THE MLS REGISTER

The HPCSA is re-evaluating the original criteria set for articulation from their MT register to the MLS register which unfortunately will result in further delays to the process.

Those who have already applied may not be aware that there has since been a change in the level descriptors between the previous ND and BTech: Biomedical Technology and the new BHSc: Medical Laboratory Science degree. This could affect those applicants whose highest qualification is a B-Tech/NHD at NQF level 7 and they may be required to provide extra credits to bridge the gap to the BHSc: MLS at NQF level 8. Individuals with a Masters (M Tech) or higher qualification should not be affected.

We understand that some applicants may prefer to wait till they receive the final directive from the HPCSA, however if anyone would like to check if they now fall in the group requiring more credits and wish to start pursuing this avenue in the meantime, please contact Wendy Solomon who has kindly offered to assist and advise applicants of their options.
